

Start in Lubango

This motorbike tour explores Angola, a country of 1,246,700 km², with elevations ranging from sea level to the highlands of Huambo and Huíla, reaching 2,620m at Morro do Moco.

Taking place on paved roads, the route offers a smooth riding experience, although some sections require special attention.

The itinerary, planned for two weeks and around 3,970 km, includes visits to emblematic places such as Luanda, Kalandula Falls, Serra da Chela and the Namibe Desert.

It also includes an excursion to Namibia, with a safari in the Etosha National Park, visits to Tsumeb and the largest meteorite in the world.

The journey is followed by a support vehicle to ensure comfort and safety.

The event is non-competitive, promoting a relaxed adventure tourism experience, combined with camaraderie and the discovery of stunning landscapes, with local hospitality always present.





















Day 01

- Arrival in Luanda and transfer to Luanda Airport Domestic flight terminal;
- Flight from Luanda to Lubango;
- Transfer from Lubango Airport to Cásper Lodge;
- Accommodation and dinner at Cásper Lodge in Nossa Senhora do Monte Park.

- Delivery of the motorbikes to participants after breakfast;
- Tour arround Lubango with visits to Tundavala Rift, Leba Mountain, Cristo Rei (Christ The King) and an afternoon snack at Le Chalet;
- Accommodation and dinner at Cásper Lodge.







Day 03

- Departure to Namibe (400 km), via EN 280, descending the Leba mountain heading to Moçâmedes;
- City tour and ride to the desert to discover the Welwitschia Mirabilis:
- Lunch at Clube Náutico de Moçâmedes, overlooking the Mirage Beach;
- Departure to Lubango mid-afternoon;
- Return trip via Bibala, ascending the Chela mountain;
- Stop at Chela mountain to enjoy the sunset;
- Arrival in Lubango at nightfall;
- Accommodation and dinner at the Casper Resort.

- Departure to Namibia (600 km);
- Route: EN 105, Chibia, Quihita, Cahama, Cunene River, Ondjiva and Santa Clara border post;
- Angola-Namibia Border Crossing;
- Ride along the B1 road and the gravel road to King Nehale Resort;
- Accommodation and dinner at King Nehale Lodge.







Day 05

- Free day at King Nehale Lodge Safaris in Etosha;
- Day dedicated to Safari photography in Etosha National Park in resort vehicles;
- Wildlife experience, including springboks, zebras, ostriches, giraffes, oryx, elephants, lions and the black rhinos;
- Full board accommodation at King Nehale Resort (breakfast, lunch and dinner).

- Departure to Tsumeb (180 km);
- Visit of Otjikoto Lake 20 km from Tsumeb;
- Arrival in Tsumeb mid-afternoon, city tour and check-in at Kupferquelle Resort;
- Dinner at Kupferquelle Resort.







Day 09

- Departure to Lubango (440 km);
- Namibia-Angola Border Crossing;
- Arrival in Lubango in the late afternoon;
- Accommodation and dinner at Cásper Lodge.

Day 07

- Free day in Tsumeb;
- Tour and visits around the area, including the Tsumeb Museum and the Hoba meteorite (80 km from Tsumeb);
- Accommodation and dinner at Kupferquelle Resort.


- Departure for Oshikango (320 km);
- Arrival in Oshikango in the late afternoon;
- Accommodation at Palmeiras Lodge



Day 10

- Departure to Benguela (360 km);
- Journey along the EN 105, via Cacula with a brief stop in Quilengues and arrival in Benguela in the afternoon.
- Accommodation and dinner at the MilCidades Hotel

- Rest day, with a visit to the beaches of Baía Farta, Baía Azul and Caotinha;
- Accommodation and dinner at the MilCidades Hotel







- Visit to Kalandula Falls shortly after breakfast;
- Departure to Luanda in the late morning (360 km);
- Arrival in Luanda in the late afternoon;
- Accommodation and dinner at Ilha Mar Hotel at Ilha de Luanda, with direct beach access straight from the hotel.



Day 12


- Departure to Rio Uíri Farm (330 km);
- Route: Restinga do Lobito, EN 100 towards Canjala, Cubal River, Quicombo and Sumbe. Later enter EN245, ascending Dinguiri hill, towards Uku/Seles and Conda;
- Arrival at Rio Uiri Farm in the late afternoon;
- Overnight and dinner at Rio Uíri Farm.

- Departure to Kalandula (480 km);
- Route: Conda, Gabela, EN 120, Quibala, Lussusso, Kwanza River, Cambambe Dam, Alto Dondo, Pungo Andongo, Cacuso, EN322, to Kalandula.
- Scenery of coffee plantations, mountains, granite outcrops, and farms;
- Visit to the Black Rocks of Pungo Andongo;
- Arrival in Kalandula in the late afternoon;
- Overnight and dinner at Pousada Kalandula.





- Visit to Miradouro da Lua, 50 km south of Luanda;
- Visit to places such as Avenida Marginal, Miramar neighborhoods, Vila Alice, Alvalade and Praia do Bispo, the Nazaré Church, Luanda Fortress and Agostinho Neto Memorial.
- Possibility to include places suggested by participants;
- Arrival at the hotel before sunset;
- Return of the motorbikes;
- Transfer to Luanda Airport's international flight terminal.

The design, organization and oversight of this trip are managed by an experienced team in events of this nature, not only in Angola but throughout Southern Africa and in different parts of the world. The team leader, Jorge Portugal, born and raised in Angola, has road travels as his greatest passion. Since childhood, alongside his father, he enjoyed exploring the country, becoming a profound connaisseur of **Angola's** roads and tracks, capable of describing routes by heart, even without a map.

A private pilot of both aircraft and automobiles, Jorge has also developed navigation skills, essential for planning safe trips tailored to the specifici characteristics of the terrain and participants. Among his remarkable experiences, stands out the organization of the Paris-Cape Town Rallye (Dakar 1992) in Angola, the founding of TTT-Turismo Todo Terreno and Raid Cacimbo, the largest off-road event that takes place annually in Angola, since 1996!

Jorge is a member of the motorbike group "Eleven's" and since 2010 he has participated in major motorcycle trips throughout Angola and the world, including; "BigSix" in 2010 (Luanda-Maputo-Luanda), "Eleven UP" in 2011 (Luanda- Addis Ababa -Cairo-Tripoli-Tunis-Marseille-Porto) and other stages of the Eleven's group's trip around the world, covering Europe and Russia (2013), North America (2015), South America (2017), Australia (2019) and Asia (2023).

The team has also experienced support vehicle drivers, ensuring technical and logistical assistance during the trip.
