

Day 1 - 10.Oct Arrival in Luanda

PROGRAM

- Arrival in Luanda and transfer to Hotel Ilhamar at Ilha de Luanda;
- Delivery of the motorbikes to participants in the afternoon;
- Dinner at the "O Naval" restaurant, at Clube Naval de Luanda, overlooking Luanda Bay;
- Accommodation at Hotel Ilhamar.

Day 2 - 11.Oct Luanda

- Luanda city tour;
- Visit to Miradouro da Lua, 50 km south of Luanda;
- Arrival at the hotel before sunset;
- Dinner at the hotel Restaurant, followed by rest for an early departure the next day





Day 3 - 12.Oct Luanda - Benguela

360 Km

- Departure to Springok -South Africa (420 Km)
- Route: Keetmanshoop-Noordoewer-Springbok
- Namibia- Rep. South Afica Border crossing;
- Accommodation at Mountain View Guest House

THE TEAM

The organization and monitoring of each trip is handled by a team with extensive experience, not only in Angola but also throughout the Southern Africa region and various parts of the world.

Tours Cacimbo.ao is led by Jorge Portugal, an Angolan with deep knowledge of the roads, trails, and sometimes almost impassable paths of Angola.

With experience in aeronautics and automotive, he participated in the organization and reconnaissance of the Rallye Paris-Cape Town (Dakar 1992) through Angola, founded TTT- Turismo Todo Terreno, and in 1996 launched the emblematic annual off-road event Raid Cacimbo.

More recently, since 2010, he has been riding extensive kilometers on two wheels around the world with the group Eleven's.

He has participated in and co-organized short-distance motorcycle trips (Angola, Namibia), mediumdistance trips (Luanda-Maputo-Luanda, South Africa, Botswana, Zambia, and Zimbabwe), and long-distance trips (Luanda-Addis Ababa-Cairo-Tripoli-Tunis-Marseille-Porto) and other regions covering Europe, Russia, North America, South America, Australia, and Asia.

A driver with extensive road and off-road experience both in Angola and surrounding countries, Brejnev offers safe driving and logistical support adapted to various contexts.
