



THE TEAM

The organization and monitoring of each trip is handled by a team with extensive experience, not only in Angola but also throughout the Southern Africa region and various parts of the world.

More recently, since 2010, he has been riding extensive kilometers on two wheels around the world with the group Eleven's.

He has participated in and co-organized short-distance motorcycle trips (Angola, Namibia), medium- distance trips (Luanda-Maputo-Luanda, South Africa, Botswana, Zambia, and Zimbabwe), and long-distance trips (Luanda-Addis Ababa-Cairo-Tripoli-Tunis-Marseille-Porto) and other regions covering Europe, Russia, North America, South America, Australia, and Asia.
